Mad Scientist, Magicians and Potions, Oh My!

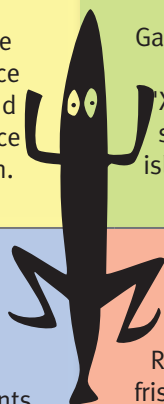
JULY 12 to 16

Station Road Nursery School – Fun-In-The-Sun Summer Camp Terms and Conditions for July/August 2010

Please read the following as they apply to your child's successful experience with the Fun in the Sun Summer Camp.

- Each child MUST be at least 3 years of age to attend and they all must be toilet trained.
- We are a NUT FREE school so please refrain from bringing any items that contain nuts OR may contain traces of nuts, as it can be deadly to other children.
- Allergies, Medications, Special Needs, and Behavior Concerns – Please indicate in writing any allergies, medications, behavioral concerns, or other items of concern that your child may have. Please be specific in listing the allergies and the reactions your child may experience.
- Each child brings his/her own lunch and snacks. An ice pack is required in all lunch bags. All items are to be in clearly identified containers.
- Photographs are taken throughout the summer and posted within the school. The Advocate newspaper may also come and take pictures and we would only provide each child's first name to be identified in the newspaper.
- Children may go on small hikes in close proximity to Centre 2000. Staff will notify you weekly of these special excursions.
- In the event of an emergency, you understand that the Staff or its representatives will call 911 for an ambulance. Parents will be made aware of the situation immediately. Any cost for the ambulance will be the responsibility of the parents, not the school.
- Any child who is verbally threatening to another child or staff, or any foul language is used or unacceptable behavior persists; the child's parent will be immediately notified and the child may be asked to leave the camp without refund.
- All children will only be released to those individuals identified on each child's registration form.
- At any time any child may be required to be picked up immediately due to illness, injury, or a communicable disease so please ensure a contact name and number is available at all times of an individual who we can reach during the camp hours. If you wish to add someone to our list during the summer, please bring a written note to the Supervisor to add to your child's record.
- Always remember to sign-in and sign-out your child as this helps us to ensure the safety of each child.
- Tax receipts will be issued.
- Please feel free at any time to speak with our Counselors or Camp Supervisors to address any questions or concerns you might have, we're always here to help!
- These terms and conditions are for the safety and satisfaction of all students and staff so we require that everyone abide by them at all times during the camp.
